In PLR 202208005, the IRS ruled that a solar energy facility will not be considered public utility property (PUP) because its rates are fixed and not determined on a cost-of-service, rate-of-return basis.

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) published a private letter ruling stating that facilities that generate solar electricity are not public utility property (PUP) under the Internal Revenue Code.

The final regulations clarify, through examples, that tangible assets needed to modify and upgrade transmission or distribution systems beyond the interconnection point are considered qualified ...

Public Acts 108 and 109 were approved by the Governor on July 26, 2023. The Acts provide for the establishment of solar energy districts and exempt "qualified solar energy facilities" from ad valorem ...
