While there's little a homeowner can do to prevent solar panel damage resulting from inclement weather, there are several ways to keep panels operating efficiently the rest of the time.

The short answer is: yes, a cracked solar panel will still work, at least partially and temporarily. However, this comes with significant caveats for both short-term operation and long-term ...

Some damaged panels keep producing power while slowly degrading components. It's like driving a car with the check engine light on - you might make it home, but the repair bill could give you heartburn.

Even if a solar cell has been damaged, that doesn't compromise the entire panel. Panel performance drops in proportion to the total amount of damage. For example, 10 to 20% of your solar ...

While a broken solar panel may seem like a lost cause, it's important to understand that it could still have some functionality left, depending on the extent of the damage.
