

How long can potatoes be stored in a storage cabinet

How do you store potatoes?

As in the ground, potatoes need to be stored in a place with some air flow. Potatoes can be stored loose, but this can get a bit chaotic. Instead of an airtight container or plastic bag, opt for a cardboard box or a storage bag made from breathable fabric, such as a netted, mesh or hessian bag to stop sweating, sprouting and rotting.

Do potatoes need to be stored in a container?

Even with the right containers and storage spots, potatoes still need a little attention now and then to stay at their best. Potatoes should not be stored next to onions, bananas, apples, tomatoes, or avocados. These fruits and vegetables give off a gas called ethylene, which speeds up sprouting and can even change the flavor of your potatoes.

Do potatoes last longer in a pantry or storage area?

If possible, make sure your pantry or storage area has good air circulation. Potatoes will last much longer if the air is moving rather than stagnant. Potatoes don't belong on your counter--they're not exactly the prettiest produce to display, anyway.

Should potatoes be stored in a cardboard box?

This simple storage swap can make a huge difference. In our storage showdown, we found that potatoes stored in a cardboard box fared better than those stored in a bowl, a basket, and a plastic or paper bag. They had the fewest sprouts and remained snappy, moist, and firm to the touch. When cooked, they retained their flavor the best as well.
