The government of Kosovo this week announced it will build a battery energy storage system (BESS) with a capacity of 200MWh-plus to deal with the country's energy crisis.

Kosovo will conduct its first wind power tenders in two rounds, each for 75 MW to 100 MW. The ME plans to issue the first call for qualifications in October 2024.

Kosovo intends to build the first battery energy storage system (BESS) in the region, which will have 170 MW of capacity and come online in 2028, a senior government policy advisor told Montel on Thursday.
