Additionally, according to the Energy Law, power plants that use variable renewable energy sources are required to install an electricity storage facility within the power plant with an installed capacity ...

The government is likely to replace the dormant heavy oil-fired "TEC Negotino" power plant with a new gas-fired power plant. The government has negotiated a loan with the EBRD to finance the construction ...

To provide a basis for comprehensive energy sector reforms in North Macedonia and across the region, the OECD Development Centre has developed an Inventory of Energy Subsidies and Support Measures in the ...
