

Will there be an inverter next to the photovoltaic panels

The inverter is like the backbone of your solar setup - it converts the direct current (DC) from your solar panels into alternating current (AC), the type of electricity your home can use.

Should I place the inverters closest to the panels, or closest to the final destination to avoid line loss, overheat, etc. Either inverter location is equal: indoors, sheltered, etc.

Micro-inverters and power optimizers are installed near or under the solar panels. But string inverters can be installed indoors or outdoors as per the homeowner's requirements and installer ...

If you place several inverters in the same room, you have to consider placing ventilation entries and exits to make sure the inverters are sufficiently cooled. If needed, you can increase the space ...

Probably next to the panel but you can't be too sure. If it's a large system that needs a supply side connection they may prefer to do it by the meter. Other details could matter too.

Microinverters are installed under solar panels and designed for outdoor use. If your solar panels are grid tied (as most are), the installer will recommend the best place to install the inverter.
